Thank you for joining us in prayer while we are in Grenoble, France serving the North African Muslim immigrant culture present there. Grenoble is nestled in the French Alps halfway between Geneva, Switzerland a two-hour drive to the North and the Mediterranean Sea a two-hour drive to the south. Similar to the heart-wrenching refugee crisis we see happing in the Middle East, similar circumstances were and prevalent in the Northern African nations which led many families to flea everything they knew at home to find refuge in Southern Europe. This is still taking place, so while there are families that are second and third generation immigrant families, some are only a few months fresh to Europe.

In Grenoble, there is a significant divide between the French culture and the North African culture. The North Africans know they are not wanted there and the French would rather them go back to North Africa. Because of this divide, the two cultures have not assimilated with one another. Imagine if you were one of the North Africans who lived day in and day out on the fringe of society and all the sudden you have a team of 10 Americans who are being neighborly with you, praying with you, bringing you a home cooked meal and cleaning your home. Wouldn't you want to know why they were there in the first place and then why they were being so kind and friendly? That's exactly the spot where we find most of these people, eager to hear the message that we traveled so far to share! We are equally as eager to join Roy, Jen and the rest of the Nagelkirk family in reaching the lost with the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ!
