

Weekly Focus: Open Door Project Update

Each year, we have the opportunity to give to our Open Door Project, a mission-focused offering developed with prayerful consideration. Typically, the Open Door Project is emphasized at the end of year. This year, because of the excitement of Grace Beyond, we've said less about it so far. The quiet, behind-the-scenes approach doesn't mean God hasn't been at work! Here are some of the things for which we are already praising Him.

Just this past week, one of our project partners, Horizons International, shared the following news: "Horizons Center in Tripoli, Lebanon, which was closed by the authorities is now open! After several months of closure, the staff are cleaning the place to ready it for the Grand Reopening." Please join us in praying for God to use this center's staff to meet the physical and spiritual needs of refugees in that city. Pray for our Christian brothers and sisters throughout Lebanon, where one in every four people is a refugee, as they welcome these strangers in the name of Jesus and share with them the good news of his salvation.

The centerpiece of the Open Door Project is the *West Michigan Friendship Center.* By God's grace, people from Calvary and other churches in our area are already developing a place where ethnic refugees, immigrants, and residents of our community can find friendship, genuine care, and welcoming community in the name of Jesus. The legal papers for tax exempt status are being prepared, and a team is searching for a location.

God is using Calvary's New Neighbors refugee program to open our hearts and minds to the nations He has brought right to us. As one Calvary volunteer said, "To us, they're no longer refugees - they are people with names, personalities, dreams and needs. We can barely understand each other so we laugh together at our foibles. They could be our neighbor. . . They **are** our neighbor."
