## weekly focus: student missions

Each summer Calvary students participate locally, across the country, and around the world as we partner with various ministries and missionaries on mission trips. The work and ministry that takes place on these trips is beneficial to our missionaries, but these trips are also a place of tremendous growth for students – spiritually, mentally, and emotionally. This summer 100 middle school and high school students will take part in several different Calvary short-term mission trips:

- Fifth and sixth graders will once again spend a few days right here in Grand Rapids serving our community through organizations such a Dégagé, Alpha Women's Center, Urban Family Ministries, and many others.
- Seventh and eighth graders will travel to Cincinnati to engage with the community through acts of service, evangelism and support to local churches.
- High school students will spend a week in Madison, Wisconsin reaching out to the homeless population in unique outreach opportunities such as Habitat for Humanity, homeless shelters, food banks and more.
- A different group of High School students will visit Portland, Maine and connect with Pauper's Chapel, one of Calvary's church plants. They will assist the church in their current ministry as well as spread the love of Jesus in the community.
- Several high school students will also join teams headed to Guyana and Spain to support our missionaries in those locations by planning and leading VBS, English camps, and other activities.

More than anything, these students need our prayer support. Join us in praying for team unity, for wisdom and energy for leaders, for students to come home strengthened in their faith, and for God to work powerfully as they serve. Pray also that these experiences would be the beginning of a life of service and witness for the Lord.

Each student is responsible to raise support to go on these trips.
