It never fails! Every person I have ever spoken to says the very same words. "I went to minister to them, but what I didn't expect was to be ministered to." I was privileged once again to lead a small team to Calvary's long-time sister village of Chinhangane, Mozambique in October.

Our teachings for this trip focused on Bible stories of faith and stewardship. It was amazing while speaking the words of these teachings to witness the Holy Spirit unlocking the truth of each story. While teaching, I was made aware that as the words flow through the translator from English to Chingane, they again flow through the Holy Spirit that translates their truth onto the hearts of each person. At the end of each story, I was given the sense of accomplishment, contentment, obedience, and peace that the Holy Spirit had used this teaching in their spiritual development.

What I was un-prepared for was what occured at the end of the third teaching. When the Bible reference was given, many purposed to write it down. For those that had a Bible, some wrote it in the front, some on a scrap paper, others on a notepad. But what hit me like a brick and brought a tear to my eye was two women who had no place to write it down, and instead, painstakingly inked it onto each other's forearm. Thank you Lord for reminding me anew of the value and importance of your life-changing word!


