

weekly focus: central-asia trip

There is still opportunity to join the Short-Term Mission Team serving in Central Asia this summer. The trip is scheduled from June 16-30. We are planning to provide encouragement and support for the pastors and church workers in Central Asia by hosting a training retreat for them, as well as participating in a camping excursion that will focus on making connections and sharing the gospel with teenagers and young adults.

Brian, a participant in last year's team had this to say about his experience: The trip opened my eyes to the many challenges that a believer faces in a culture that does not embrace Christianity. A member of the local church told of his conversion to Christianity and how his family disowned him. We drove by a local cemetery where many of his family members and friends are buried. "But I can't be buried there," he said, "because I'm a Christian."

One of the many highlights of the trip was praising God alongside local church members and orphans around a campfire, surrounded by snowcapped mountains, and hearing the word of God preached in three different languages. It was a reminder that, despite differences in language, geography, culture and personal upbringing, we serve a global God.

If you are interested in growing in your faith, experiencing different cultures, developing relationships, and sharing the love of God with others, sign up soon because training for the team is scheduled to start shortly. While this can be a rather challenging trip, it has been an incredible blessing to those who have gone and to those we have served.
