God has been teaching Calvary how to care for those who are marginalized and hurting in our area. Calvary is organizing an “Affordable Housing” committee that will come alongside a local nonprofit, *Partners in Housing*. PIH buys manufactured homes and refurbishes them for a homeless family to own. This creates stable and affordable housing with the average cost at \$450/month. They have acquired two new homes for Calvary volunteers to refurbish. We need you to help with demo, renovation, furnishing, and even stocking the pantry of this new home. Here are ways you can help:

- Electrical repair
