The Elders have made the decision to put the vote on constitutional updates on hold until Spring 2019. The meeting and vote on October 28 is canceled.

As we move forward, the Elders would like to hear from members of the congregation. You have an opportunity over the next two weeks to affirm the direction of the updates on the ballot. Whether you call this a straw poll, a survey or vote of affirmation, the elders are essentially asking Calvary Church members to join us on this journey and affirm the direction we are moving before we continue down this path any further.

As a reminder, these updates are a response to God's leading and a desire to better align our constitution with Scripture. The proposed updates are:

- 1. Strengthen and clearly define Calvary's definition of marriage;
- 2. Allow women to serve in the role of deacon;
- 3. Move the annual congregational meeting and board start date back by one month.

A summary document on these updates is available at the Welcome Center and the Chapel Information Center.

There are surveys in the back as you leave the Sanctuary. Members, please fill one out and deposit it into the drop boxes at the Welcome Center or Chapel Information Center by November 4. If you have already submitted an absentee ballot for the original vote, we will count that as your submission to this survey. You do not need to vote again.

We thank you for your support and ask for your continued prayers for the leadership and for Calvary Church as a congregation as we seek to faithfully follow the Lord on this journey.

Finally, you are invited to gather with other church members to learn more about these updates and ask questions of the elders and Pastor Jim Samra at a lunch on October 25 at 12:00pm in the Gathering Place. *Please register at mycalvarygr.org by October 23.*


