Receptivity – Pray confidently for many open hearts and minds in both adults and children.... "As for what was sown on good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it. He indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundredfold, in another sixty, and in another thirty." Matthew 13:23

Opposition – Pray for God's power to conquer all fears, doubts and struggles in ministry. "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in heavenly places." Ephesians 6:12

Transitions – Pray over the transitions they make to different cultures and languages; especially for their children. "I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. I do all this for the sake of the gospel, that I may share in its blessings." 1 Corinthians 9:22-23

Friends – Pray for their children to have close friends to support them and walk with them. "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up." Ecclesiastes 4:9-12


