However, we stepped out in faith and obediently signed up to be foster parents. The day that our license arrived was the same day that our first foster care child arrived. We were excited for the arrival of a three-month old baby boy that evening, but also filled with compassion for this little baby's parents. With God's help and the encouragement of our family and church we were able to take care of him and form relationships with his mom and relatives during the nine months that he was in our full time care. We were blessed to be able to celebrate this child's first birthday with our friends and some of his family. While this child has now been placed with his grandmother, God has still allowed us to maintain a good relationship with the child and his family. The child's relatives even call us a part of their family! We have seen God working in many ways through this experience and are encouraged to know that He actively shows His love to the children and the parents who find themselves in the foster care system. We are humbled to have been some of the vessels He has used to show love to those who need it!

Forever Hope Orphan Care exists to support families within our congregation, like the one who shared their story above, who are caring for orphaned and vulnerable children. There are numerous ways to get involved which include prayer, preparing meals, babysitting, encouraging a family to becoming a foster or adoptive parent.




