- 1. Scholarships are available up to 2 weeks before an event "as funds" are available.
- 2. Scholarships will be granted based on need.
- 3. All scholarships require a minimum payment with application.
- 4. As a general rule, scholarship grants will not exceed 50% of event costs. Special circumstances will be taken into consideration.
- 5. After 2 requests for a scholarship, the family requesting the scholarship will need to be referred from the Pastoral Care Center before more scholarships are granted.
- 6. When a scholarship is granted, students / parents should exhibit wise stewardship in regard to "add-on" events (i.e. skiing, etc)
- 7. All scholarships must have completed scholarship forms.
