Sermon Discussion Questions

1. Sometimes the Spirit of The Lord tries to grab our attention in numerous ways (small and big) throughout the week. This seeking our attention could happen through things like songs, verses, devotionals, trials, conversations, someone you're sitting next to, a prayer, and etc.

Were there any ways this week that you sensed the Spirit of the Lord in your life this week? If so, what were the ways in which you sensed Him?

2. On Sunday's the Holy Spirit can highlight different things for each person throughout our gathering. What were some of the things that you noticed, this can be certain phrases in songs, something Jim said during the teaching, a word from Isaiah 55, etc?
3. On Father's day we spoke about our Heavenly Father and the ways in which He loves us. Isaiah 55 is an invitation to come to our Heavenly Father. When you consider this invitation to come to Our Savior, what emotions and thoughts do you have?
4. Sometimes discouragement, guilt, shame or fear can hinder us from coming to our Father. We may feel that we don't pray enough, or less than because we can't understand something in the Bible, or that we can't come to Our Lord based on our past. Are there things that hold you back from taking that invitation from Our Heavenly Father?
5. We can often focus on the things we are not doing and miss the small steps of faith that the Spirit through Jesus' faithfulness is doing through us. What have been some of the steps of faith that you have been entrusting into the Lord and you have noticed are different about yourself?
6. What are some areas that our Heavenly Father may be asking you to trust in His love today? What fears, guilt, shame, defeat, rejection, abandonment, and discouragement can we lay at Jesus feet?
